Poverty

- 1. Saskatchewan has the lowest minimum wage in the country. Do you support an increase?
- 2. The poverty line in Saskatchewan for a single person is \$1868 per month. Do you support an increase in social assistance rates to raise people out of deep poverty to the poverty line?
- 3. Do you support universal basic income, a guaranteed liveable income that will sustain every person's basic needs?

Housing

- 1. What is the plan for a cold weather strategy for winter 2024/25? Do you support access to housing for all Saskatchewan residents and a strategy to end houselessness?
- 2. We have over 3000 vacant social housing properties. What is your plan to address these vacancies?
- 3. 80% of Canadians live in areas with rent control? Do you support rent control policy for Saskatchewan?

Education

- 5 provinces in Canada, including the three largest; have language in collective agreements related to class size and complexity. Do you support the same agreement in Saskatchewan?
